TRIP TO CUBA | OCTOBER 11

A TEAM OF 12 is scheduled to leave for Holguin, Cuba to present pastors with the Foundations for Living Seminar to give them instruction and 'tools' (discipleship manuals) to begin a discipleship ministry in their churches. This

area will receive 50,600 books for training and discipleship manuals. The Santiago area, where we presented a seminar in 2015 will receive another 8,000 books for training and discipleship. The total cost for all these books was over \$44,000. This money has already been sent to Cuba. Each team member will take an extra suitcase full of clothing and medicines, etc. to leave with the pastors and wives.

PLEASE PRAY for anointing, health and safety for all the team members. Also pray that all the materials we still need to take with us will pass customs. Also pray for safety for the 300 pastors and their wives as they are on constant threat of persecution. Corrie ten Boom, a holocaust survivor is to have said, **"Safety is not so much the absence of danger, but the presence of God"**. Pray that our whole team will sense the presence of God in every place and circumstance.
